Violence against women is one of the human rights violations that has the highest prevalence and a local dimension in Ecuador. It affects 1 out of 4 women in the country, according to the Global Femicide Study (GFS) 2020. The report shows an increase in violence against women in Ecuador in 2020, with 10,000 cases reported.
